About KDE and KDE Eco

KDE is an international community dedicated to developing Free and Open Source Software (FOSS) for end users. Contributions are made by thousands of talented volunteer contributors (developers, artists, marketers, translators, documentation writers, etc.) from all over the world. KDE e.V. is the legal organization behind KDE that represents and supports the community, which includes KDE Eco.

KDE Eco is comprised of two projects: FEED and BE4FOSS. The "Free and Open Source Energy Efficiency Project" (FEED) is developing tools to improve energy efficiency in Free and Open Source software development. "Blauer Engel for FOSS" (BE4FOSS) is a repository for collecting, summarizing, and spreading information related to Germany's Blue Angel eco-certification as well as to resource efficiency in general as it relates to FOSS development. The overarching aim of KDE Eco is to strengthen sustainability as part of the development of Free Software.

You will be responsible for implementing the content by building the site in Hugo in the existing KDE website structure. Therefore you will be working together with the team of the organization. The structure and content will be provided by KDE Eco. If needed we will get external help for the production of visual content.

The final website will be launched at the latest by the end of 2021. However, before then we would like to have a version online including the basic structure and a homepage by November 10th.

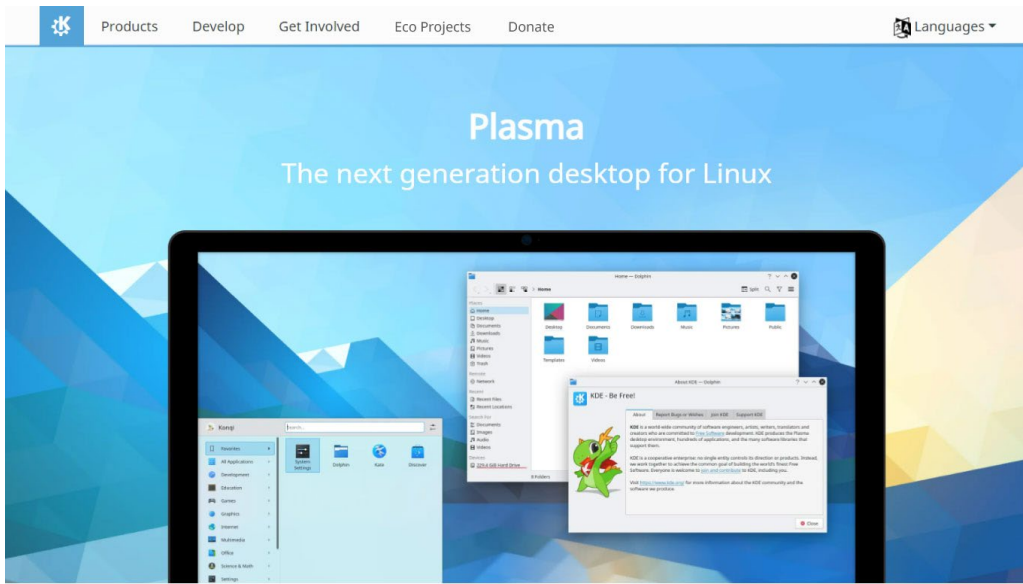

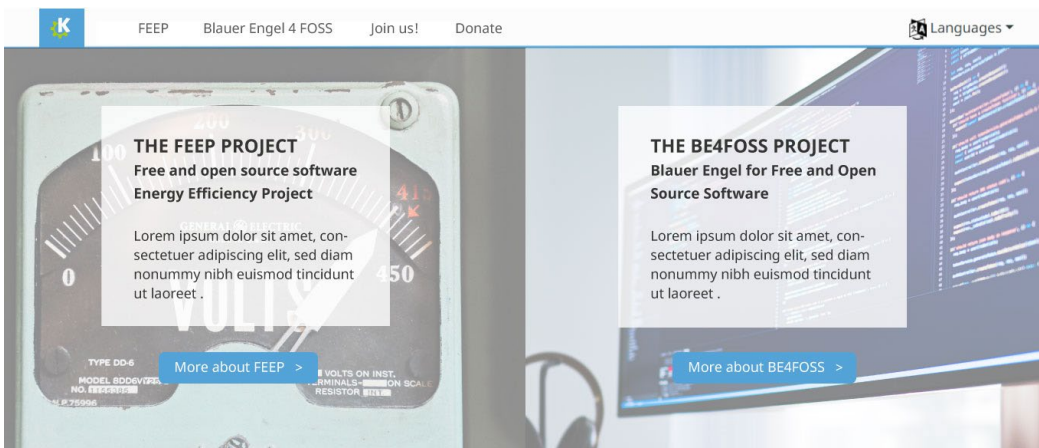
